

Dear Community Members,

The Future Impact Group (FIG) through the Make George Town Yours project, would like to share with our community members, an exciting new development that is coming to Macquarie Street. Over several years FIG has conducted extensive community consultation where it has been identified that the community wanted to improve the look and feel of Macquarie Street. In response to this feedback, we are installing four planter boxes on all four intersecting corners of Macquarie Street and Sorrell Street.

The planter boxes will be constructed from Corten Steel, to match the aesthetic of the Make George Town Yours Macquarie Street Entry Statement and the George Town Councils Metal Sculptures project. A graffiti resistant finish will be applied as well as sealing the boxes so that there is no leakage on the footpath. The planter boxes will also be on lockable wheels so they can be moved. A tree will be planted in each planter box with some additional vegetation, including edible herbs.

Four planter boxes (one for each street corner on the intersection) are being constructed locally by CPT Engineering.

This development serves to build on the work already undertaken by the Make George Town Yours project in the Macquarie Street precinct (Parklet Pilot Project, Macquarie Street Entry Statement).

We are striving to build a lively and exciting space for community members and visitors to enjoy. Please find an example image of similar planters below, along with an aerial view of the locations.
